

Case Study: Greater Helsinki Vision

- Open competition
- 86 accepted competition entries from all over Europe
- Interdisciplinary design teams with a strong focus on urban design and planning
- Dec 2006 – May 2007
- Awarding authority: City of Helsinki and other surrounding local authorities, supported by the Finnish government
- Goal: Increased intercity competitiveness and sound growth strategy




Spatial representation of a region







Basic Framework






